



TEM SDA FAQ – FAQ’s that we will ask you.....

Read this in conjunction with the TEM General Catalogue (TGC) and SDA Brochure.

We need to know.....

1. Type of construction, Hollow Wall/Cavity, Brick-Masonry or Poured Concrete-Rammed Earth? You can mix but we need to know how many of which type?
2. Style required – LINE, SOFT, PURE or Antibacterial? Again, you can mix and match however if you intend to use or upgrade to PURE then we need to know as they use different frames. *See TGC Pg 8.*
3. Colour(s) required. PW or IW are the most common and are the same price, other colours cost more. *See TGC Pg 12-27.*
4. Buttons: Colour required. Do you require LED Indicators, if so then what colour? *See TGC Pg 40.*
5. Switches: Make sure that you indicate what type of switch you require, (2 Way, Intermediate or other special) SM10 is the standard ON-OFF Toggle, all other types of switching are variations. *Refer to the TGC page 50.*
6. Do you require Etching or engraving of symbols on either the Surround or Button? (Not available on any Black Surface). *See TGC Pg.40.*
7. Sockets: Available in Switched or Auto Switched, check dimensions as Switched Double Sockets can be on the large side. *See separate SDA Brochure.*
8. Do you require IP55 Switches or Sockets? *See TGC Pg.57 & Pg147-151.*
9. Dimmers: Do you require a separate ON/OFF Switch?
10. USB Chargers, Data, TV and HDMI sockets are available and can be placed in sets with sockets. (Sockets are housed in separate boxes). *See TGC Pg. 64.*
11. Check Set sizing, SDA is considerably larger than you would be used to. Dimensions are available on the Fact Sheet. *See TGC Pg.117.*
12. NM72 sized sets are not SDA compatible – ask your SDA Advisor for substitutes.
13. Any other special features that you may require?

If you are unsure of the answers to the above, we suggest you contact either your Architect or SDA Adviser. SDA is customised to the clients needs, there is no one size fits all solution unless you choose the Gold Standard.
